London Colney Residents Get Heard!

London Colney Parish Council are pleased to announce that following on from the public meeting and roundabout protest, Hertsmere BC have agreed to consult with residents of neighbouring authorities about any possible development on the boundaries with St Albans District Council.

Cllr Malcolm MacMillan said, "We will be postponing our protest march on Hertsmere Borough Council's offices, scheduled for 28 February, following Cllr Harvey Cohen's agreement to arrange suitable sessions to encourage participation and harness further views on their proposals to build a garden village on the boundary with London Colney. It just goes to show that by enabling residents to express their views about unwarranted development which would impinge on a neighbouring parish, other authorities are listening to us."

Further public meetings and possible protests will be organised when potential plans from Hertsmere are published.
