## 4,000 turn-out for village fireworks spectacular

A RECORD ATTENDANCE OF OVER 4000 PEOPLE ATTENDED THE PARISH COUNCIL'S ANNUAL FIREWORKS DISPLAY

Last year's fireworks attendance of 2,300 was well and truly smashed as over 4,000 people gathered on Morris Playing Fields at Whitehorse Lane for the 2018 extravaganza on Sunday 4 November. Entry to the display is free of charge with donations collected for three local organisations and charities. This year's recipients are The Peace Hospice, 1<sup>st</sup> London Colney Scouts and the local Women's Institute.

Cllr. Malcolm MacMillan, Chairman of Council said: This was the best and biggest ever show. It was a happy occasion and the public were most appreciative of the event. It's great to be able to give something back to the community which benefits so many people in a joyful way"

The Chairman thanked all volunteers, councillors and staff for their contributions in ensuring a safe environment for spectacular fireworks. "It's been months of preparation and behind the scenes planning which paid off with a huge attendance. Recently a new spec was issued for the 25-minute show and it seems the public liked what they saw".
