#### 1. SUMMARY

- 1.1 Larks in the Parks is a District Wide event, run in areas of deprivation and multiculturalism. Everyone Active (previously 1Life), delivered the event on behalf of the District Council. It has been run since 2007. SADC's contribution to the event was to help with the organisation, complete the paperwork for submission to the Safety Advisory Group (SAG), provide some entertainment, an activity and first aid cover.
- 1.2 Other sites include Cottonmill, Fleetville and Batford. The event in London Colney is the largest in the district probably and has been a fixture in the events calendar for many years.
- 1.3 The Events schedule during the summer months has already seen the inclusion of a large family event with Picnic in the Park held in August. There could be seen to be some duplication in running two events with only two months between them. This could be an opportunity to relaunch a London Colney based event, at a new location, with a different offering for the community.

#### 2. **RECOMMENDATION**

2.1 Members are asked to consider how they wish to proceed in light of this decision.

#### 3. BACKGROUND

- 3.1 The Events budget for 2023/24 has already been approved by the Finance & General Purposes Committee and will be approved at the Council meeting on 18<sup>th</sup> January 2023.
- 3.2 SADC's financial input into the event covers the following areas:
  - Entertainment Act
  - Art activity
  - First Aid
  - Marketing
- 3.3 Comparing the cost of first aid cover for other activities, it is estimated that we could cover the first aid requirement at a cost not exceeding £250.
- 3.4 A sum of £150 for marketing would cover the replacement banners required to advertise the event, as the existing Larks in the Parks banners are logo'd as SADC. There would also be some printing of leaflets.

- 3.4 Everyone Active will be seeking funding from other sources to support the event.
- 3.5 The last meeting of the Events & Community Committee approved the new location of Morris Recreation Ground for the event in 2023.

4.1 See budget below. There has been an additional sum included for first aid cover (£200) and marketing (£150).
